The following information is intended for clubs, teams and individual players wishing to participate in the 28th Annual Cricket Sixes Tournament in Hua Hin, Thailand in 2025.

Tournament Dates: **8 –13 July 2025**

Hua Hin (180 km south of Bangkok) is one of Thailand's top tourist destinations. The city boasts many beautiful beaches, Temples, night markets, a water park and an array of outstanding restaurants and casual dining bars and cafes. Hua Hin also offers some of the best golf courses in Thailand.



Accommodation

The tournament takes place in the grounds of the magnificent Dusit Thani Resort, Hua Hin.

The Dusit is world class hotel with all the facilities you would expect from a 5-star resort.

Situated on an idyllic stretch of sand on the Gulf of Thailand, the Dusit Thani combines resort luxury on the beachfront with spacious grounds comprising an ornamental lake, lily-pond, tropical gardens, two magnificent swimming pools and a range of recreational facilities. Some of the amenities offered are:



- Several excellent restaurants and bars on-site and nearby.
- Plentiful amenities for children including kids' club and sandy playground. (Babysitting available)
- Elegant rooms with stocked minibars, and private furnished balconies.

What about the cricket?

Cricket is played within the resort grounds, five minutes walk from your room or poolside.

It is six-a-side cricket, and each team plays one or two matches per day lasting around 40 minutes.

Competition is in three divisions:

Cup (open age), Masters (over 35) and Vets (over 50)



- A minimum of six and a maximum of eight players may be registered per team. If you are unable to form a team, you can join another team by contacting the organizer.
- It can get hot (34°C plus) therefore, cricket attire is shorts, and team playing shirts (which are provided as part of the Cricket Fee) and rubber soled shoes.
- Depending on the numbers, a Super Vets and Women's Division may be considered for 2025

Who Plays in this tournament?

All types of cricketers, from club level to the internationally experienced in the Cup to the wily skills of the Masters and Vets.

In the past, teams from Asia and the subcontinent, UK and South Africa have participated in the tournament. Also, a strong contingent from Australia, including members of the Melbourne Cricket Club have entered high quality teams for the Cup and other divisions.

Over 40 current or former First Class and Test Cricket players from many different nations have played in the various divisions, adding to the competitiveness of the tournament.

In 2025, we are seeking increased participation from women's teams, with the aim of creating a Women's Division. Over past years the Melbourne CC has entered a team and depending on numbers an invitation will also go out to the Thai Women's Cricket. The teams are normally assigned to either Masters or Vets entry if a separate division is not possible.



It's not just for cricketers

Family and partners are very welcome. They can enjoy the usual pleasures of a tropical holiday in Thailand. From the incredible facilities of the hotel to the wide range of tourist and sporting attractions surrounding Hua Hin.

The Black Mountain Water Park



The Black Mountain Water Park is spread out over 40,000 sq m and is located just 20 minutes from central Hua Hin.

It is one of the most popular tourist attractions in the region. The Park is full of high quality and modern equipment, all operated in line with the highest standards of safety and with highly trained lifeguards.

There is a 17-metre tower with 9 different slides, a spectacular wave pool which makes the biggest waves in Thailand, a lazy river, a beach/infinity pool, and children's pool, all for treating the visitors to a fun day. Check opening dates and times.

How to get to Hua Hin



Flights are your own responsibility, so dates and times are to suit your personal preferences. Most people get in one day or so prior to the tournament start date.



On arrival in Bangkok transport to the hotel is by private car, luxury minibus or tourist bus depending on your group size. The distance from Bangkok to Hua Hin is 180 km and travel is via freeway, with frequent stops for drinks and food available.



Bookings can be arranged for your internal transfers; just nominate your flight date and mode of transport to the organizer. Child restraints can be organised.

Costs

Accommodation rates are heavily discounted. Tour participants can also enjoy special prices at the bars and restaurants of the hotel.
